

ALSIKE CLOVER

PERENNIAL CLOVER

Alsike Clover is a perennial or biennial native to Europe. It has a prostrate to ascending stems with pink and white blossoms in round heads and can reach a height of 2-4 feet. **Alsike Clover** is tolerant of acid and base-reacting soils and wet sites. This particular clover performs best when it is partnered with grasses, which makes this clover an ideal choice for hay, pasture and soil improvement areas. **Alsike Clover** is also very beneficial for honey bees.

PLANTING TIPS

- ◆ Drill or broadcast seed 1/4 to 1/2 inch deep
- ◆ Inoculate seed prior to planting to induce nitrogen-fixation
- ◆ Plantings should be made in spring or late fall in cooler climates, late summer in warmer or southern climates.
