ALSIKE CLOVER


Alsike Clover is a perennial or biennial native to Europe. It has a prostrate to ascending stems with pink and white blossoms in round heads and can reach a height of 2-4 feet. Alsike Clover is tolerant of acid and base-reacting soils and wet sites. This particular clover performs best when it is partnered with grasses, which makes this clover an ideal choice for hay, pasture and soil improvement areas. Alsike Clover is also very beneficial for honey bees.

PLANTING TIPS

- Drill or broadcast seed 1/4 to 1/2 inch deep
- Inoculate seed prior to planting to induce nitrogen-fixation
- Plantings should be made in spring or late fall in cooler climates, late summer in warmer or southern climates.
