

MUNG BEANS

WARM SEASON LEGUME

Mung Beans are a warm season legume that is similar to cowpeas, however it has a shorter growing season. Mung beans are fairly similar in size and look to cowpeas, but the seed is smaller. This warm season legume is known for its excellent drought and heat tolerance. **Mung beans** require very little water, therefore it makes for a perfect component in grazing mixtures. **Mung beans** have excellent nitrogen fixing potential and it beneficial for surface compaction and weed control.

PLANTING TIPS

- ◆ Plant the seed 1 to 1 1/2 inch deep in a well prepared seed-bed
- ◆ For optimal results, it is important to inoculate the seed
- ◆ When planted in early June, the crop will flower in 50 to 60 days, and will continue to flower for a few weeks
